



### **Ladybird pattern.**

Double knitting wool

Needles 3.25 or old size 10.

Cast on 5st.in red

R1. Inc K wise into every stitch (10 stitches)

R2. Inc P wise into every stitch (20 stitches)

R3. K

R4. P

Repeat the last 2 rows 5 more times.

Break off red and join in black

Repeat R3 and R4 another 3 times.

R21 K2tog to end (10 stitches)

R22 P2tog to end (5 stitches).

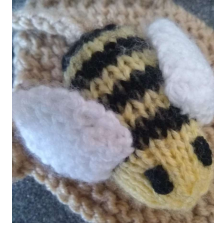
Break off yarn and thread back through the five stitches tightly and fasten off.

Stuff and sew up the back.

Decorate the back as shown using a back stitch down the centre.

Use a symmetrical spot pattern on the back and a couple of eyes.

Smaller version, start with casting on 4 stitches.



### **Bee pattern.**

Double knitting wool

Needles 3.25 or old size 10.

Cast on 5st.in black

R1. Inc K wise into every stitch (10 stitches)

R2. Inc P wise into every stitch (20 stitches)

Join in yellow

R3. K

R4. P

Repeat the last 2 rows 5 more times alternating two rows black and yellow

Break off black and continue only in yellow

Repeat R3 and R4 another 3 times.

R21 K2tog to end (10 stitches)

R22 P2tog to end (5 stitches).

Break off yarn and thread back through the five stitches tightly and fasten off.

Stuff and sew up the back.

### **Wings make 2.**

Using white cast on 4 stitches.

R1 inc K wise into each stitch (8 stitches)

Knit 13 rows the break off yarn leaving enough to thread back through the stitches and pull up tightly and fasten off.

Sew on to back and sew on two eyes.



Beetle pattern.

Double knitting wool

Needles 3.25 or old size 10.

Cast on 5st.in black

R1. Inc K wise into every stitch (10 stitches)

R2. Inc P wise into every stitch (20 stitches)

R3. K

R4. P

Repeat the last 2 rows 8 more times.

R21 K2tog to end (10 stitches)

R22 P2tog to end (5 stitches).

Break off yarn and thread back through the five stitches tightly and fasten off.

Stuff and sew up the back.

Decorate the back as shown using a back stitch down the centre and across the back as shown in the picture and a couple of eyes.

I then attached pipe cleaners for legs. I have spare if you just make the body.

Dragon fly.

Double knitting

Needles 3.25 or old size 10.

Cast on 12 stitches in black

R1 Cast off 3sts, kfb x 4, k1, cast off remaining 3st this makes the antenna.

R2 Join in blue P

R3 K2, Kfb, K4 Kfb, K2

Every even row is purl

R5 K2, Kfb,K6,Kfb

R7 K2tog, repeat to end of row (7 stitches)

R9 Join in green Kfb in each stitch (14 stitches)

R11 K

R13 K

R15 K3 Kfb 8 times, K3 (22 stitches)

R17 K2 tog, repeat to end of row (11 stitches)

R19 Join in black K

R20 P in black

R21 Join in blue K

R22 P in blue

R23 black K4 K2tog K5 (10 stiches)

R24 P black

Continue on these 10 stitches for 5 more stripes 2rows black, 2 rows blue ending with a blue stripe.

R35 K2 tog across black

Break off yarn and thread back through the five stitches tightly and fasten off. Stuff and sew up seam. I used pipe cleaners for wings. (I have spare)
